**MURAL AT VETERANS MONUMENT
TO BE ADDED AT FREEDOM PARK**

The San Dimas HEROES organization has commissioned San Dimas High School art teacher Dominic Black to design a mural for the Veterans' Monument.

The proposed mural will be painted by Black and his art students from San Dimas High School. It will be located on the newly constructed south wall of the monument, which will not be needed for the addition of veterans' names until after the north wall has been completely filled. Plans are to have the mural in place for the monument unveiling and dedication ceremonies on Veterans' Day, November 11, 2013.

Gary Enderle, President and Co-Founder of San Dimas Community Foundation/HEROES, is proud that Black and the art students are interested in taking on this project. All of the public schools in San Dimas, including San Dimas High School, have worked hard to help raise money for the monument, and the monument's mural project will provide the students more pride of ownership as they become the caregivers of tomorrow.

Mr. Black is a professional artist with a proven track record. The Veterans Monument mural project will be their fourth San Dimas Student Art Public Project, as there are already three student mural projects in San Dimas that were designed and painted by Black and art students from the high school. The student mural projects have been very well received within the community.
